

The English-Language Reception of Kracauer's Work: A Bibliography

Thomas Y. Levin

The following preliminary survey of the English-language secondary literature on the work of Siegfried Kracauer is divided into three sections: A) reviews of Kracauer's books, B) obituaries, and C) more general essays on Kracauer. It is meant to supplement my bibliography of primary texts entitled "Siegfried Kracauer in English: A Bibliography" (*New German Critique* 41 [Spring-Summer 1987]: 140-50).
